

# 1772 FOUNDATION AWARDED PROJECTS 2018



For the eighth consecutive year, 1772 Foundation partnered with the New Jersey Historic Trust to offer Capital Preservation Grants up to \$15,000 to nonprofit organizations for exterior repair and restoration projects. The grants require a one-to-one match from the grant recipient, and are limited to certified 501(c) 3 organizations, excluding schools and religious congregations.

Since 2011, the Historic Trust has recommended grant awards totaling over \$2 million for 187 projects, in partnership with the 1772 Foundation.

In 2017, the Historic Trust evaluated 55 applications requesting \$652,284 and recommended funding totaling \$293,786 to 25 applicants.

The following grants were approved by the 1772 Foundation at its April/May 2018 meeting:






